

We have seen in the past two weeks the type of redemption in creation

| 1. There was darkness | Man without hope |

I. Jesus in **day one** of creation (Jesus incarnate) the Light of the world

A. "...and the Spirit of God was hovering the face of the water." (VS-2)

1. "hovered" of Gen 1:1 = To be moved, affected, specially moved with tender love.
2. Luke 1:35 = God's Spirit "overshadowed" Mary

³⁵ And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God."

3. God's Spirit has shown compassion and will usher in the Word of God.

B. "...then God said let there be light..." (VS-3)

1. The spoken Word brought forth light.
2. The incarnate Word brought forth light (Luke 2:9)

⁹ And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid

3. Simeon filled with the Spirit when seeing the infant...(Luke 2:30-32)

³⁰ For my eyes have seen Your salvation Which You have prepared before the face of all peoples, A light to bring revelation to the Gentiles, And the glory of Your people Israel."

C. "...and God saw the light that it was good..." (VS-4a)

1. God's first public words to Jesus Matt 3:17

¹⁷ And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

D. "...and God divided the light from the darkness..." (VS-4b)

1. Jesus was man, but not of man. Wholly God and man but sinless.
2. (Hebrews 7:26) Shows the separation of Christ from sinners

²⁶ For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens;

E. "...God called the light day..." (VS-5)

1. The light was named by God
2. God the Father named the Light of the World. Matt 1:20-21 & Is. 49:1

²⁰ But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. ²¹ And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

"Listen, O coastlands, to Me, And take heed, you peoples from afar! The LORD has called Me from the womb; From the matrix of My mother He has made mention of My name.
